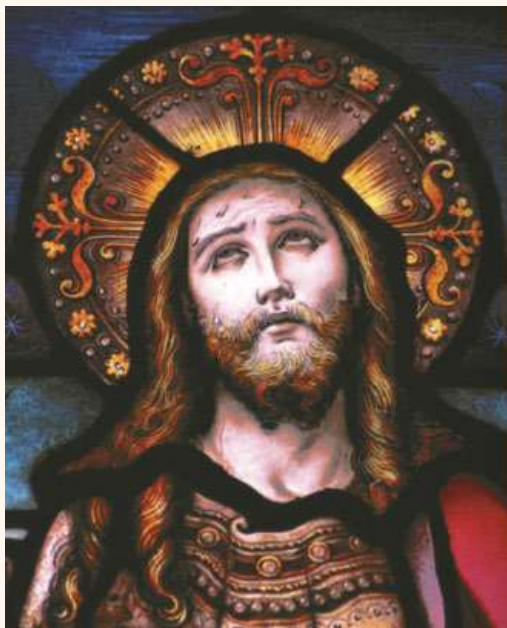

## SAVE THE DATE—EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION ON JUNE 2ND

Dear Parishioners,

The Church encourages Eucharistic procession on Corpus Christi Sunday. In the seminary we learned of such processions in Medieval times in which anyone passing by would immediately genuflect and make the sign of the cross. Oh, how we would like those days to return!

This year, we have much in play as we consider how to worship our Lord more fervently, commit ourselves to devotion to the Holy Eucharist, and to tell others about Him in the Blessed Sacrament. As part of the National Eucharistic Revival, spearheaded by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, there will be four Eucharistic processions from the North, South, West, and East all meeting at the national conference this summer in Indianapolis, IN. The Marian route from the North will begin on May 17<sup>th</sup> in Bemidji, MN at a conference there that weekend and pass through here in our Archdiocese. As a flagship portion of the route, we will have a Eucharistic procession from Saint Paul Seminary to the Cathedral of Saint Paul on Memorial Day, Monday, May 27<sup>th</sup> from 12:45 PM to 4:00 PM. However, we are going to have a Eucharistic Procession of our own! On Corpus Christi weekend (June 1-2), Masses at Guardian Angels will be at the normal times of 4:30 p.m. Saturday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, and 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Sunday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> -- however, there will not be a 12:30 p.m. Latino Mass at GA, nor will there be any Masses at Saint Nicholas. At the end of the 10:00 a.m. Mass at Guardian Angels, we will begin a Procession to Saint Nicholas traveling a route through Chaska to the path along the river. We will walk down the path until we emerge into the town of Carver close to Casey's. From there we will walk up the hill to Saint Nicholas and have a brief time of prayer in the Prayer Garden, followed by Benediction in the church. Then you are invited to join in for a picnic lunch and fellowship on the grounds of Saint Nicholas.

We will have transportation provided for those who can only walk part of the way and shuttle return to Guardian Angels. We will have games and activities for kids. We will do this in order to celebrate our own faith in fellowship together as Catholics in our Lord, Jesus who loves us and gives Himself to us in the Holy Eucharist. We will give witness to our faith, including having something to hand out to others passing by.

You may be wondering why we have not participated too much in the National Eucharistic Revival. We have begun Year I of our synod implementation process that involves beginning small groups. Year II will focus on the Mass in terms of our catechizing, celebrating, and devoting ourselves once again to this great mystery. We are a year late, but our small groups will only help us to pray about, reflect together, and ultimately give witness to our understanding of and devotion to the Holy Mass. May God bless these efforts and the day of Corpus Christi for us!
