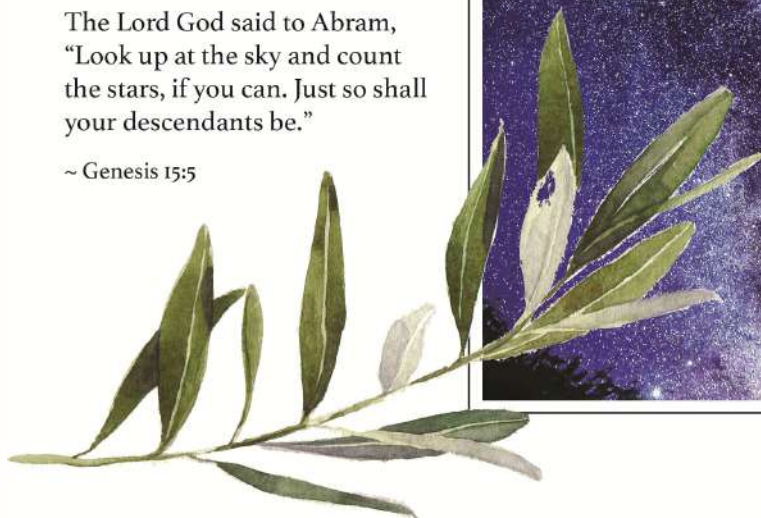

Lenten Almsgiving

Traditionally, the three pillars of Lenten spiritual practice are Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. We are invited to do something for each of these throughout Lent such as extra prayer, or fasting by giving something up, or extra giving for the poor as our almsgiving. Beginning next week, we will provide an opportunity for almsgiving at each of our weekend Masses at both Guardian Angels and St. Nicholas. We'll do this for three weekends in a row.



- March 23 & 24 Pack a pickup at GA; bring something for the Bountiful Harvest Food Shelf and place it in one of the pickup trucks outside the Church. At St. Nicholas bring something for the food shelf and we'll collect it in the Church.
- March 30 & 31 Global Solidarity Sunday; As part of the Archdiocesan effort we will take up a collection at both parishes that supports the church in poor parts of the world.
- April 6 & 7 Tanzania Orphans; We'll take up a collection in support of the St. Monica School for Orphans in Mtamba, Tanzania in Africa. My good friend Fr. Augustine Mbiche began this school as a kindergarten in 2005 and now it has 350 students in grades K-7.

I thank you for your generous and sacrificial giving for those in need during this Lenten season. May God Bless you in your Lenten practices. See you at the Fish Fry!
