Lo que quizás no hayas escuchado son los notables detalles que rodean el juego de tributo que se jugó para él el 12 de julio, que resultó ser el primer juego en casa de los Angels después de su muerte.

Muchos notaron que el juego fue el 12 de julio, la víspera del cumpleaños 28 de Tyler. Los Angels ganaron y el puntaje fue de 13 a 0 sobre los Marineros de Seattle. "Trece" es la fecha del cumpleaños de Tyler. El primer jonrón del día navegó a 454 pies. El número de Tyler fue de 45 y el juego resultó ser un juego sin hits. Dos lanzadores, Taylor Cole y Félix Peña, combinaron sus esfuerzos para este logro. Eso es algo raro, sin duda, pero lo sorprendente es el hecho de que la última vez que un bateador lanzó en California fue en la fecha del nacimiento de Tyler 13 de julio de 1991. ¿Ya tienes la piel de gallina?

Agregue a esto lo impresionados que estaban todos por el lanzamiento de apertura por su madre de un golpe justo en el centro del plato. Y todo el equipo usó "45" y luego los jugadores colocaron sus camisetas "45" en un círculo alrededor del montículo de lanzamiento en un hermoso homenaje a él.

Con tanta gente entristecida por su muerte, especialmente su familia, uno no puede dejar de pensar que algo divino y muy especial estaba ocurriendo con todo esto. ¿Coincidencias? Nah! Con solo una pequeña cantidad de fe, no es difícil ver la mano misteriosa de Dios dejando que su familia sepa que todo está bien. Dios siempre está ahí para nosotros, siempre cuidándonos incluso en medio de grandes dificultades, tristezas y pérdidas. Que Dios descanse su alma y consuele a su familia.
