

## **Negative interest rates** and our Catholic faith

Perhaps you've heard that interest rates are actually negative in Europe and Japan these days. In this upside-down world, it actu-



ally pays to take on debt as the credit markets favor the borrower rather than the lender. A negative interest rate encourages people to borrow to stimulate the economy. But those who deposit money at banks (essentially the "lenders"), have to pay a percentage, or fee, for the convenience of having a checking or savings account. Governments sell bonds that are worth less when they mature than when they are purchased.

How can this possibly be? While there are many factors at work, the price of money, *i.e.* interest rates, like any other commodity decreases when there is less demand for it. Essentially, there is less demand for money in Europe, and Japan at this time relative to previous times. A quick check of the demographics reveals that the populations of Europe and Japan have been stagnant, or declining, for decades. Fewer babies equals less demand for money to purchase clothing, food, education, housing, vehicles, pretty much everything.

Fewer couples need to borrow like my parents did for their growing family in the 1950's and 1960's. Or like in the 1970's and 1980's when interest rates were a sky high 21% in the United States as large numbers of baby boomers became adults and borrowed strongly for houses, cars, etc. as they started their families. Today our society encourages childless coupling through contraceptives, abortion, and same sex coupling. Combined with the recent decreases in immigration both legal and illegal, it means that our country is probably not far behind Europe and Japan with a decreasing population and negative interest rates to follow.

Our faith teaches us that God made man and woman to be "fruitful and multiply" (Genesis 1:28). Our Catholic faith has warned for decades against the use of contraceptives that puts a barrier between man and woman separating them as in the Garden of Eden. Today lots of people have sex, but fewer, and fewer actually conceive children. Of those who do conceive, more than one million are aborted each year. All of this has consequences for the broader society. We tend to think of sex as a very personal and private thing, and indeed it does occur in private. But the implications of it are very public. Our not very far down the road negative population growth and negative interest rates will be living proof of this reality. Fall Blessings,


