

Dear Parishioners of Guardian Angels and Saint Nicholas,

It happens sometimes that, with changes in parishes, changes to their structure, and changes in leadership and staffing, that we experience hurtful situations or situations that cause us to have to re-adapt. Sometimes these situations can be painful because what was once familiar, good, and meaningful seems to have come and now gone. During other times our parish has not changed so much, but our life has. We experience what

seems to be a time of desolation after a time of relative good due to divorce, job changes, sudden changes due to the decisions of family members and otherwise.

Sometimes, we need a little help to better understand and cope with what seemed unfair or what has left us feeling as powerless as a leaf blowing in shifting winds. I am quite sure that it is not so easy to make a commitment to make time on a Friday night and entire Saturday to hear about, talk about, or even acknowledge the difficulties we have experienced or the problems that they have caused. It is just not natural to want to do it.

Yet, when we do, we open ourselves for God to come into our lives in a new and fresh way. Revelation 3:20 says, "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, [then] I will enter his house and dine with him, and he with me." We have an opportunity to open the door to Christ through a Healing the Whole Person Retreat offered by Father Joseph Bambenek, priest of the archdiocese, who has offered such a retreat in his own parish in White Bear Lake. He will offer the retreat on Friday evening, September 15th and Saturday September 16th for the duration of the day.

I encourage you to consider signing up to come to this retreat. It will include Masses, being prayed with, talks, reflection, music, lunch, dinner, and more. Come away for awhile to pray with our Lord and be healed! Please see the article in this bulletin for more details and the forms in the back of church for more information and to sign up.

When and Where will it be?



About the Retreat Leader

Fr. Joseph Bambenek is the Assistant Director of the Office for the Renewal of Structures. In that role, Fr. Joseph and his team will support Fr. Tony in the coming year as he discerns, with the help of parishioners, how best to shepherd the Catholics of Chaska and Carver given current realities. When Fr. Joseph was pastor of St. Pius X, White Bear Lake, he felt inspired to develop a "Healing the Whole Parish" retreat in response to the challenges then facing his parish: a revolving door of pastors (4 in 18 months) when he arrived, the closing of the parish school, and the clergy sexual abuse crisis in the Archdiocese in which it came to light that St. Pius' founding and longest-serving pastor was credibly accused of abusing multiple children.

On August 26th and 27th, Father Gregorio Domilies will celebrate Masses with Guardian Angels and Saint Nicholas to make an appeal for The Missionaries of Jesus. The Missionaries of Jesus (MJ) is an international and multicultural religious missionary community. It was founded in the Philippines on June 12th, 2002 by a group of forty-one men called and inspired by the mission and humanity of Jesus, who calls us to "make disciples of all nations" (Mt 28:19). We call ourselves, "friends and disciples." It is our desire to gather more friends and co-disciples.

Our objective is the promotion of the universality of the Christian message through presence, witness, dialogue, proclamation, and prayer.

Our mission is to unveil the real face of Jesus hidden in our brothers and sisters in any mountain and plain; forest and city we work and live – as we gather Jesus' friends and disciples.

We are working in the Philippines in (Antipolo, Modesta, Cubao, Baguio, Davao, Digos, Lanao, Lubang Islands), in Papua New Guinea (Lae), in Guatemala (Tierra Blanca) and in the USA (Los Angeles and Washington, DC).

Among the priorities of the Missionaries of Jesus is to work and live with the indigenous people to engage in:

- 1. Relief and health care for the indigenous people in the Diocese of Lae in Papua New Guinea.
- 2. Education Work (Literacy Program) among the indigenous people in the mountains of the Prelature of Digos, Philippines.
- 3. Pastoral work (Catechetical Formation) among the catechists in the Parish of Marahan in Davao, Philippines and also in the Parish of San Marcos in the Prelature of Peten, Guatemala.




