DEACON DISCERNMENT DAY, SEPTEMBER 2012

One Sunday morning, 11 years ago after Mass I got a tap on the shoulder from sister Teresa Jose, one of our beautiful nuns at Saint Therese. She tapped me on the shoulder and said, "John, make sure you pay attention to the article about Deacon Discernment Day in today's bulletin." To which the only proper response was, "yes, of course sister". I remember thinking...Hmmm.

And so, I did. I had a few of those little prods to check out what a Deacon is. Sister's invitation was another one of those confirmations that maybe I had better check it out. I'm not getting any younger after all.

And so, I went. The day answered questions about what a Deacon is but did not answer my question if I was being called to serve Jesus and his Church as a Permanent Deacon. That came much later, and after many baby steps of personal growth.

My two take-aways from the discernment process is first, my discernment was very gradual. There were no lightning bolts. But there were gentle nudges all along the way to go deeper and just see where the next step takes me.

The second takeaway is one that thankfully continues to this day, and I think will always be present. That is, a sense of peace, contentment, and the energy I need to do what God is calling me to do. I have come to believe this to be a general truth about spiritual life. If you are in stride with what God is calling you to do, no matter how challenging that may be, peace, contentment and energy comes with the call. The Permanent Deaconate is richly rewarding for those who answer the call.

If you have ever felt that gentle nudge to see what the Permanent Diaconate all is about, here is your tap on the shoulder. 


